



Annual Recognition Dinner of Greenwich Scouting

April 29th, 2010

On April 29th, 2010 the Greenwich Council will honor a number of Scouters for their outstanding service to Scouting in the Town of Greenwich. The following awards require nominations. Please complete the forms and return them to the Council Service Center by **Friday, March 26th, 2010**.

Silver Beaver

The award is made for noteworthy service of exceptional character to youth by registered Cub Scouter, Scouters, and Venturing Leaders within the territory under the jurisdiction of a local council.

Each duly chartered council shall be entitled to one nomination. The awards shall be made to the recipients by the local council concerned at a public function. *The Greenwich Council may award 1 Silver Beaver this year.*

District Award of Merit

The District Award of Merit is a council award presented by districts in the same manner that the Silver Beaver is a national award presented by councils.

The award is available to Scouters who render service of an outstanding nature at the district level. The award is made available annually on the basis of 1 for each 25 traditional units or fraction thereof. The district need not present all the awards to which it is entitled each year.

It is not appropriate to nominate a Scouter who has already received this award. A professional Scouter or other council employee may not receive this award based on employment service. However, a professional Scouter or employee who also serves as a volunteer Scouter may be eligible, based on volunteer service. *The Greenwich Council may award 2 District Award of Merit this year.*

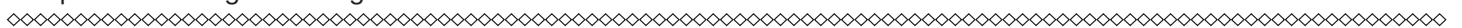
Greenwich Scouters Award

The Greenwich Council Scouters Award is available to Scouters registered in the Greenwich Council, Boy Scouts of America for a minimum of five years, and who have rendered service of an outstanding nature.

The award is made available annually on the basis of 1 for each 15 units or fraction thereof. The Council need not present all the awards to which it is entitled each recharter year. Any awards not issued in any recharter year are not carried forward into subsequent years. *The Greenwich Council may award 3 Greenwich Scouters Awards this year.*

Veterans Award

Scouters desiring recognition as 5-, 10-, 15-, 20-, 25-, 30-, 35-, 40-, 45-, 50-, 55-, 60-, 65-, 70-, 75-, or 80-year veterans must have maintained an active registered relationship for the required number of years, paying the annual registration fee. Those seeking recognition at the April 26th Recognition Dinner, who have not already completed an application in the past must have a completed Veterans Applications turned in to the Service Center by March 26th, 2010. Anyone who anticipates receiving this recognition is asked to double-check their status at with Council Service Center.
