GREENWICH COUNCIL SCOUTERS AWARDS

GENERAL INFORMATION:

The Greenwich Council Scouters Award (hereafter known as GCSA) is available to Scouters registered in the Greenwich Council, Boy Scouts of America for a minimum of five years, and who have rendered service of an outstanding nature.

The award is made available annually on the basis of 1 for each 15 units or fraction thereof. The Council need not present all the awards to which it is entitled each recharter year. Any awards not issued in any recharter year are not carried forward into subsequent years.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. A nominee must be a member of the Greenwich Council, Boy Scouts of America for a period of five years or more as a registered adult Scouter.

2. A nominee must have rendered noteworthy service to youth in Scouting.

Note: The nature and value of "noteworthy service to youth" may consist of an activity/event or decisions that contributed vitally to the lives of large numbers of youth or it may have been rendered to a small group over an extended period of time.

Consideration must be given to the nominee's Scouting position and the corresponding opportunity to render outstanding service beyond the expectations of that Scouting position.

The nominee's attitude toward and cooperation with the district(s) and or council is to be taken into consideration.

PROCEDURE:

1. Annually, the "Nomination for Greenwich Council Scouters Award" form shall be made available to all members of the Greenwich Council, Boy Scouts of America at least three weeks prior to convening the GCSA Committee.

2. Annually, the GCSA Committee shall meet and consider all candidates. A simple majority of the committee present shall constitute a quorum. Each successful candidate must receive a majority of the vote. The GCSA Committee shall forward the names of the successful candidates to the council through the Scout Executive.

3. The Scout Executive shall have the recipient's name and date engraved in the presentation medal.

Note: The wearing of any uniform insignia is not authorized.

4. The following procedure is suggested for such presentation ceremonies:

- A. The recipient and appropriate guest (s) should be in attendance at an annual meeting or recognition dinner.
- B. A member of the Greenwich Council Key-3 should explain the award and its' significance.
- C. The award should be presented at this time with appropriate congratulations.
- D. A group picture may be taken for use in neighborhood or community newspapers.
