*Life To Eagle Seminar gives hints to young Scouts*

Seton Scout Reservation - On October 22nd, over 20 Scouts along with their parents and several Unit Leaders attended the Life to Eagle Seminar. The Seminars intent was to give young Scouts, particularly Star and Life Scouts, a helpful guide towards achieving the rank of Eagle Scout.

Several speakers addressed topics that are not exactly black and white, such as: when do I need to complete this all by? What's the Leadership Service Project and where do I begin? What's this Court of Honor all about? And *who sign's what, where?*
